



1 Article 6, Section 1-4, (B)(2) Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico 1994 (ROA  
2 1994) requires that: “Reasonable notice shall be given to the public prior to any meeting of any  
3 public board, commission or committee. At least once a year, each public board, commission or  
4 committee shall determine what is reasonable notice to the public; provided that in no event shall  
5 notice be less than the notice required for Council (i.e. Albuquerque City Council) meetings.”;  
6 and

7 **Whereas**, the *Joint Air Quality Control Board Ordinance*, Chapter 9, Article 5, Section  
8 1-3, (C) ROA 1994 and Bernalillo County Ordinances, Section 30-32(c), require that: “The  
9 Board shall meet in public facilities with public seating available. The Board shall meet monthly  
10 if a quorum is available unless a meeting is unnecessary or delayed for good reason. The Board  
11 shall hold a minimum of six monthly meetings a year. Special additional meetings may be held  
12 as needed. Notice of time, place and agenda of meetings shall be published according to the  
13 requirements of law. Meetings, work sessions and hearings shall be open to the public.”

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE AIR QUALITY CONTROL**  
15 **BOARD HEREBY ADOPTS THESE PUBLIC NOTICE REQUIREMENTS WHICH ARE**  
16 **CONSISTENT WITH THOSE OF THE ALBUQUERQUE CITY COUNCIL AS**  
17 **ADOPTED ON OCTOBER 4, 2017 BY THE COUNCIL IN RESOLUTION R-17-239,**  
18 **ENACTMENT NO. R-2017-094.:**

19 **Section 1. Location of Meetings.** Meetings of the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air  
20 Quality Control Board shall normally be held in the Vincent E. Griego Chambers, Basement  
21 Level of the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Government Center at One Civic Plaza NW, near  
22 the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Marquette Avenue NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102, or as  
23 indicated in the meeting notice.

1           **Section 2. Regular Meetings.** Meetings will be held each month on the date specified by  
2 Air Quality Control Board resolution. Unless otherwise specified, regular meetings shall be held  
3 each month on the second Wednesday of the month at 5:30 PM. The agenda will be available at  
4 least seventy-two hours prior to the meeting from the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air  
5 Quality Control Board Liaison, whose office is located in the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County  
6 Government Center at One Civic Plaza NW, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Room 3023, near the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup>  
7 Street and Marquette Avenue NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102. The agenda will also be  
8 posted on the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board’s website at  
9 <https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board>.

10           **Section 3. Other Regular Meetings.** Notice of regular meetings other than those  
11 described in Section 2 of this resolution will be given ten days in advance of the meeting date.  
12 The notice will include a copy of the agenda or information on how a copy of the agenda may be  
13 obtained. If not included in the notice, the agenda will be available at least seventy-two hours  
14 before the meeting and posted on the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control  
15 Board’s website at <https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board>.

16           **Section 4. Special Meetings.** Special meetings may be called by the Chair of the  
17 Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board or a majority of the members upon  
18 seventy-two hours’ notice. The notice for a special meeting shall include an agenda for the  
19 meeting or information on how a copy of the agenda may be obtained. The agenda shall be  
20 available at least seventy-two hours before the meeting and posted on the Albuquerque-  
21 Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board’s website at [https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-](https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board)  
22 [quality-control-board](https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board).

23           **Section 5. Emergency Meetings.** Emergency meetings will be called only under

1 unforeseen circumstances that demand immediate action to protect the health, safety and  
2 property of citizens or to protect the public body from substantial financial loss. The  
3 Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board will avoid emergency meetings  
4 whenever possible. Emergency meetings may be called by the Chair of the Albuquerque-  
5 Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board or a majority of the members with twenty-four  
6 hours' prior notice, unless threat of personal injury or property damage requires less notice. The  
7 notice for all emergency meetings shall include an agenda for the meeting or information on how  
8 the public may obtain a copy of the agenda. Within ten days of taking action on an emergency  
9 matter, the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board will notify the Attorney  
10 General's Office.

11 **Section 6. Regular Meeting Notice Requirements.** For the purposes of regular meetings  
12 described in Sections 2 and 3 of this resolution, notice requirements are met by posting a notice  
13 of the date, time, location and agenda in the lobby of the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County  
14 Government Center at One Civic Plaza NW, near the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Marquette  
15 Avenue NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102 and by posting on the Albuquerque-Bernalillo  
16 County Air Quality Control Board's website at [https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-](https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board)  
17 [control-board](https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board). An annual calendar with notice of the date, time and location of the Albuquerque-  
18 Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board's meetings shall also be published in one or more  
19 newspapers of general circulation in Albuquerque. For regular meetings other than those  
20 described in Section 2 of this resolution, notice of the date, time and location of the meeting shall  
21 also be published in one or more newspapers of general circulation in Albuquerque at least ten  
22 days in advance of the meeting. The Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board  
23 Liaison shall also provide copies of the agendas to those broadcast stations licensed by the

1 Federal Communications Commission and newspapers of general circulation in Albuquerque,  
2 provided these entities have made a written request for notice of public meetings. The  
3 Department may also provide notice to the State Records Center for publication in the New  
4 Mexico Register.

5 **Section 7. Special and Emergency Meeting Notice Requirements.** For the purposes of  
6 special meetings and emergency meetings described in Sections 4 and 5 of this resolution, notice  
7 requirements are met by posting a notice of the date, time, location and agenda in the lobby of  
8 the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Government Center at One Civic Plaza NW, near the  
9 intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Marquette Avenue NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87102 and by  
10 posting on the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board's website at  
11 <https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board>. The Albuquerque-Bernalillo County  
12 Air Quality Control Board Liaison shall also provide copies of the agendas to those broadcast  
13 stations licensed by the Federal Communications Commission and newspapers of general  
14 circulation in Albuquerque, provided these entities have made a written request for notice of  
15 public meetings.

16 **Section 8. Hearing Notice.** For the purpose of hearings where testimony is sought from  
17 proponents, opponents and interested parties, notice requirements shall be in accordance with the  
18 New Mexico State Air Quality Control Act and Air Board procedural regulations. The Air Board  
19 staff shall provide written notice to newspapers of general circulation in Albuquerque and  
20 Bernalillo County at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of all hearings involving the adoption  
21 of, amendment to, or the repeal of a regulation of the Air Board. The Air Board staff shall also  
22 post notice on the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board's website at  
23 <https://www.cabq.gov/airquality/air-quality-control-board> if technically feasible at the time.

1 Notice of a hearing of the Air Board can be combined with the notice for a meeting. In addition,  
2 notice of proposed rulemaking shall be published in the New Mexico Register at least thirty (30)  
3 days prior to the date of the hearing.

4 **Section 9. Cancellations and Changes of Venue and Meeting Time.** Cancellations and  
5 changes to meeting times and locations may be announced at prior meetings of the Air Board or  
6 following notice requirements of this Resolution.

7 **Section 10. Accessibility.** In addition to the information specified above, all notices shall  
8 include the following language:

9 “NOTICE TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES OR SPECIAL NEEDS: If you  
10 have a disability or require special assistance to participate in this meeting,  
11 including interpretation, please contact the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air  
12 Quality Control Board Liaison as soon as possible before the meeting date at 505-  
13 768-2601. Those in need of hearing assistance may call 711.”

14 “The City of Albuquerque, the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health  
15 Department, and the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board  
16 do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, ancestry,  
17 disability, age, sex, spousal affiliation, gender identity or sexual orientation in the  
18 administration of programs or activities, in accordance with federal, state and  
19 local laws and regulations. If you believe you have been discriminated against,

23 **Section 11. Closed Meetings.** The Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control

1 Board may close a meeting to the public only if the subject matter of such discussion or action is  
2 excepted from the open meeting requirement under Section 10-15-1(H) of the Open Meetings  
3 Act.

4 **Section 11(a).** If any meeting is closed during an open meeting, such closure shall be  
5 approved by a majority vote of a quorum of the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality  
6 Control Board taken during the open meeting. The authority for the closed meeting and the  
7 subjects to be discussed shall be stated with reasonable specificity in the motion to close and the  
8 vote of each individual member on the motion to close shall be recorded in the minutes. Only  
9 those subjects specified in the motion may be discussed in the closed meeting.

10 **Section 11(b).** If a closed meeting is conducted when the Albuquerque-Bernalillo County  
11 Air Quality Control Board is not in an open meeting, the closed meeting shall not be held until  
12 public notice, appropriate under the circumstances, stating the specific provision of law  
13 authorizing the closed meeting and the subjects to be discussed with reasonable specificity, is  
14 given to the members and to the general public.

15 **Section 11(c).** Following completion of any closed meeting, the minutes of the open  
16 meeting that was closed, or the minutes of the next open meeting if the closed meeting was  
17 separately scheduled, shall state whether the matters discussed in the closed meeting were  
18 limited only to those specified in the motion or notice for closure.

19 **Section 11(d).** Except as provided in Section 10-15-1(H) of the Open Meetings Act, any  
20 action taken as a result of discussions in a closed meeting shall be made by vote of the  
21 Albuquerque-Bernalillo County Air Quality Control Board in an open public meeting.
