    - 20.11.64 NMAC

---

- Amend 20.11.63 NMAC, *New Source Performance Standards for Stationary Sources* by incorporating by reference new and modified NSPS's published at 40 CFR 60, *NSPS* from August 30, 2011 through September 13, 2013

# Key Revisions

---

- Amend 20.11.64 NMAC, *Emission Standards For Hazardous Air Pollutants For Stationary Sources* by incorporating by reference new & modified standards published at 40 CFR 61, *NESHAP*, and at 40 CFR 63, *NESHAP by Source Category*, from August 30, 2011 through September 13, 2013

# Authority

---

- **New Mexico Air Quality Control Act**
  - Authorizes and requires the Air Board to adopt, amend, or replace air quality regulations and to adopt air quality plans (SIPs)
