

**PUBLIC NOTICE FOR
THE AIR QUALITY TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT RENEWAL
FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO, MAIN CAMPUS**

The Regents of the University of New Mexico, 1800 Roma NE, Albuquerque, NM 87131 have submitted an air quality operating permit renewal application to the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department/Air Quality Program (Program) for renewal of the existing Operating Permit No. 0536-RN1, at the University of New Mexico, Main Campus (Facility). The owner of this plant is the University of New Mexico. The Facility is located at the University of New Mexico, Main Campus, Albuquerque NM 87131 (UTMZ: 13s, UTME: 352,000m, UTMN: 3,883,550 m) in Bernalillo County, New Mexico. Based on the application and information received to date and pursuant to 20.11.42 NMAC, the Program intends to issue such Title V Operating Permit renewal (Permit) to the Facility. This Draft Permit has been assigned Operating Permit Application No. 0536-RN2.

The Permittee is state chartered research university. The University of New Mexico Main Campus (Facility) consists of steam boilers, various heating equipment, combined cycle natural gas turbines, a crematorium, emergency generators, above ground storage tank, chemical usage and unpaved parking lots.

The proposed air pollution maximum allowable emissions from this facility have been estimated to be:

Box 1293, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87103.
