

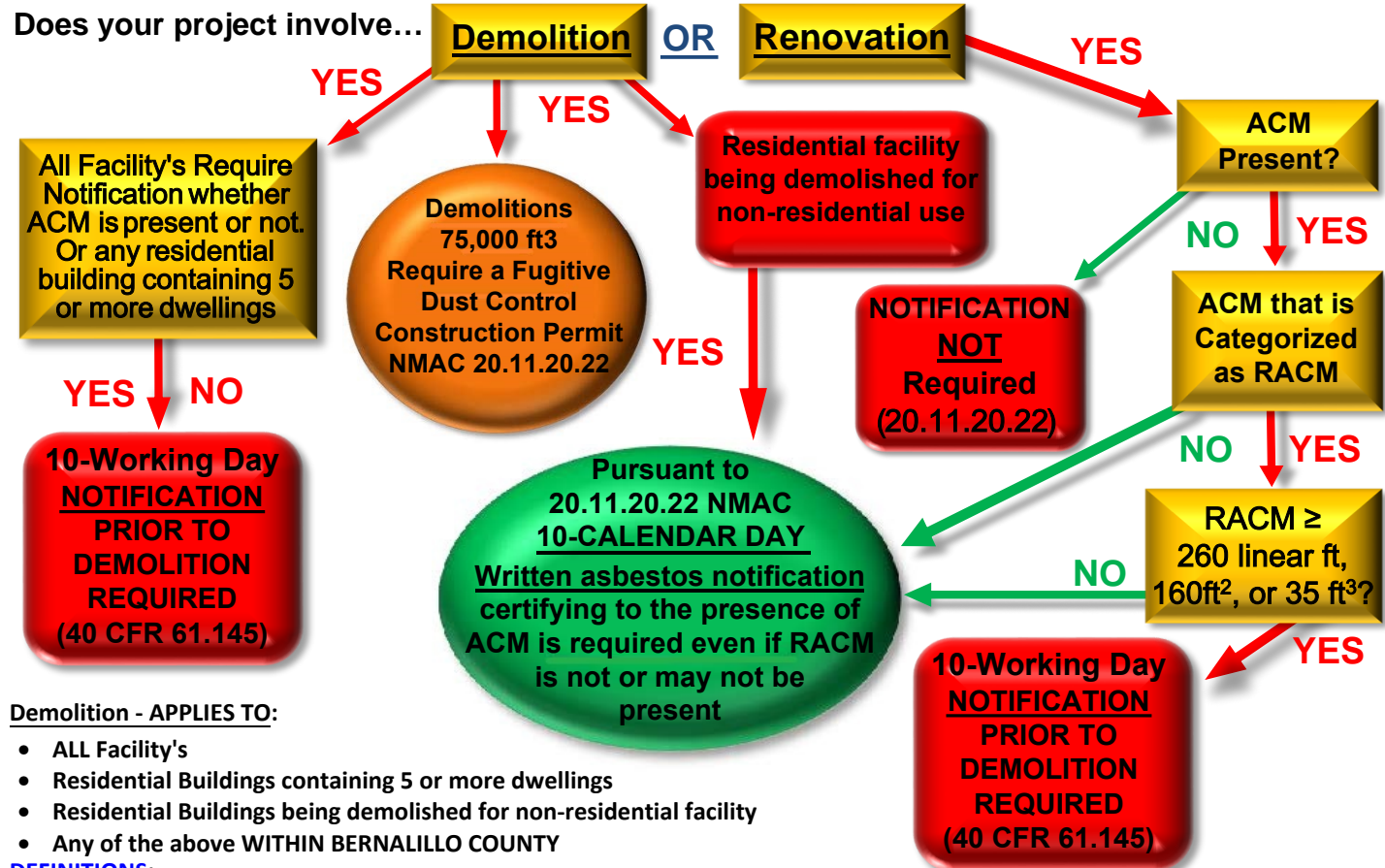

Asbestos NESHAP & Title 20 Filing Requirements Flowchart



DEFINITIONS:

- **Facility:** any institutional, commercial, public, industrial or residential structure, installation or building (including any structure, installation or building containing condominiums, or individual dwelling units operated as a residential cooperative, but excluding residential buildings having four or fewer dwelling units) Any structure, installation, or building that was previously subject to the Asbestos NESHAP is not excluded, regardless of its current use or function.
- **Demolition:** means the wrecking or taking out of any load-supporting structural member of a facility together with any related handling operations or the intentional burning of any facility.
- **Renovation:** means altering a facility or one or more facility components in any way, including the stripping or removal of RACM from a facility component.
- **RACM (Regulated asbestos-containing material):** ALL friable asbestos material, Category I non-friable ACM that is now friable, Category I non-friable ACM that will be or was subjected to sanding, grinding, cutting, or abrading, or Category II non-friable ACM that has a high probability of becoming or has become crumbled, pulverized, or reduced to powder by forces expected to act on material in course of demolition or renovation operations.
- **Category I nonfriable ACM:** asbestos-containing packings, gaskets, resilient floor covering, & asphalt roofing products
- **Category II nonfriable ACM:** material, excluding Category I nonfriable ACM, containing more than 1% asbestos that, when dry, cannot be crumbled, pulverized, or reduced to powder by hand pressure.

NOTES:

- Prior to demolition or renovation, a **thorough inspection** must be conducted at facility **CFR 61.145**. Written asbestos notification certifying to the presence of ACM is required even if regulated ACM is not or may not be present **Part 20.11.20.22 NMAC**
- Owner/operator is responsible for ensuring ACM does not become RACM, unless it is accounted for in NESHAP & fees are paid (if applicable).
