Chairman Behl called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m.

#### **Approval of Minutes**

The minutes of the June 13, 2017, Board of Trustees meeting were reviewed. Jerry Goss moved that the minutes be approved as submitted. Judy Suiter seconded, motion carried unanimously.

## Chairperson's Report - Hal Behl

- New officers will be elected at the October Trustee meeting
  - o Trustees will vote on officers progressing to the next position:
    - Hal will become Past Chair on the Board of Trustees, and will serve on the Executive Committee
    - Jerry Goss will move to the Chairman position
    - Pamela Chavez will move to the Vice Chair position
      - There was discussion about changing this position to the "Chair-Elect"
        - Cathy will see if this requires a bylaws change or approval from the City
  - o A new Secretary/Treasurer needs to be elected (No money handling involved)
    - Judy Suiter volunteer to be considered
- Hal discussed a Memorandum from the AMF for a Traveling Exhibit Support Fund
  - According to City Statutes, we have to approve agreements or MOU's to go to the City
    - The agreement would be presented to City of Albuquerque Cultural Services
    - City Attorney will review the Memorandum
    - The Foundation and Museum would like to get the Memorandum approved during the current Administration
  - o The Trustees reviewed the Memorandum
  - Wayne Chew moved to approve the principle of the Memorandum but not be bound to the decision until the Trustees receive the final version.
    - Jerry Goss seconded, the motion carried unanimously.

## **Museum Director's Report - Cathy Wright**

- The Bond Election is this fall: Please vote!!!
  - o The Museum is slated to receive
    - \$100,000 for collection development, care and acquisition
    - \$175,000 for repairs and renovation
    - The funds could be available in early spring
- June 30th was the end of the Fiscal Year
  - o Attendance was 173 people over the previous FY attendance
  - o 127,000+ visited the Museum
  - Casa San Ysidro had a 13% increase in attendance of 1,000 more people for 9,284 attendance
- The Art in the Afternoon program on Saturdays will be discontinued
  - o The program costs \$13,000 a year and special funding is no longer available
  - o Attendance numbers are not known
  - There is no connection of the program to exhibits
- First Wednesday admission is free and the museum gets many groups with special needs attending
- Casa San Ysidro
  - o The Tour Coordinator position is open
    - Jerry asked if Emily Stovel isn't full time if her position could be combined with the Tour Coordinator position
    - Cathy explained that Emily is the back up if docents can't show up and she needs to focus all her time on the big picture of Casa
  - o There was an article in the paper today on Casa's 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday program
- The employee handbook is finished and includes details about AM duties
- The American Tribal Art Dealer's Association newsletter had an article about the Leekya exhibit Cathy passed the article around
- Trustees commented on the great job Denise is doing with marketing the Museum
  - o Cathy will ask Denise to come to the next Trustee meeting for appreciation

### Foundation Report - Dr. Deborah Good

- The Trustees welcomed Deborah to the Board
- The Foundation just finished their Strategic Plan it will go to the Board next week
- The Magic Bus solicitations are out. Discussion about the program included:
  - o The Magic Bus sponsorship is \$150
    - The cost to rent a bus is \$145 so the sponsorship barely pays for the overhead
    - The teachers only pay \$10 admission for a busload of children
  - o There are about 128-130 buses in the program
- The Foundation has a new investment manager, Chris Cates with The Cates Team at RBC Wealth Management, and is involved with the Museum
- "Arts Thrive" is moving along
  - o Studios have been visited to pick out art work
  - o Trustees are encouraged to buy their tickets now!
  - o The Gala is \$300 for both nights, including the Collectors' Dinner
- The Foundation Board meeting is next week

#### **Curator Reports**

Andrew is absent but provided the minutes from the Art Advisory Committee August 1st Meeting to distribute

#### Deb

- The minutes of the History Advisory Committee August 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting were distributed. Highlights include some memorable donations
  - o A 50th Anniversary logo mug and refrigerator magnet
  - o A Two foot section of trolley track recovered during A.R.T. construction
- Deb is working on the next exhibit in the Keleher Gallery to open on November 11th
  - o The exhibit is on the Huning Highland Addition and East Downtown focusing on how the period of reconstruction changed the district

#### Elizabeth

- There were 80 requests for the Magic Bus and Tour with AM and CSY early bookings are good
  - o Teachers' guides are provided
- Elizabeth reviewed the Calendar at the bottom of the agenda
  - o The Chatter Concert on August 3<sup>rd</sup> drew 175 people an all time high!
    - The 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday (Aug. 17) concert took place in different galleries with Chatter playing music while films were shown
  - o The 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary will include lots of events
    - On September 7<sup>th</sup>, the official 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary date, the Mayor will provide a proclamation and a press conference will be held
    - There will be tours of the storage area, sculpture tours and former Poet Laureate Jessica Helen Lopez will create and present a special anniversary original poem
    - Deb and Andrew will deliver a "50 objects in 50 minutes" talk of 25 each
    - There are 50 Historical Bits on Facebook
    - Trustees are encouraged to attend 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary events
  - Casa San Ysidro will not have a 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday program in September as they will participate in the Corrales Harvest Festival instead on 9/30 and 10/1 – it's the biggest event Casa has
  - Smithsonian Museum Live Day is an agreement with the Smithsonian where we provide a day of focus on the Smithsonian, they promote the Museum to all Smithsonian members in New Mexico and send the Foundation the mailing labels for those members

#### **New Business**

Jerry asked why we are pursuing new funds to build an Education Center when there are unfinished and unfunded Casa San Ysidro projects

- Cathy explained that costs for those CSY projects have grown
- The State pulled the funding for the Visitors Center
- CSY is working with the Village of Corrales to put a parking lot in the back of the property
