Entry Fee: \$10, payable at entrance on Old Town Rd. and 19th St. Please, no large vehicles or trailers on Mountain Rd. Cars should be driven into the show. If you have an over-sized or non-running vehicle, please get special instructions from Joyce. Follow all parking directions of volunteer assistants. Enter the show quietly, park your vehicle, enjoy the show and leave in a dignified manner. No driving, revving engines, loud sound equipment, sirens or moving displays.

No tents, canopies or stakes in the parking lot by order of the Fire Marshal. All vehicles are required to be insured. Loss or damage is the responsibility of the owner.

NO "FOR SALE" SIGNS OR COMMERCIAL ADVERTISING IS ALLOWED. NO ITEMS SHOULD BE FOR SALE.

Failure to follow these instructions can result in your removal from the show.

Registration opens at 8:30am. You must register your vehicle. Register at the north end of the parking lot with your signed entry form and the window card given to you as you entered the show.

Awards start at 3:30pm in the Museum Amphitheater.

Special displays of model and toy cars and an auto art show are in the Museum; you may visit these for no charge. If you wish to tour the rest of the Museum, there are 2 tickets in your goody bag, along with a list of displays.
