

## Butterfly Words to Know

ANTENNA: a thin sensitive organ on the head of an insect, crab, etc., that is used mainly to feel and touch things



CHRYSALIS: a hard case that protects a moth or butterfly while it is turning into an adult



NECTAR: a thick juice made from a particular fruit

POLLEN: the very fine usually yellow dust that is produced by a plant and that is carried to other plants of the same kind usually by wind or insects so that the plants can produce seeds



PUPA: an insect that is in the stage of development between larva and adult



COCOON: a covering usually made of silk which some insects (such as caterpillars) make around themselves to protect them while they grow

LIFE CYCLE: the series of stages through which a living thing passes from the beginning of its life until its death

LARVA: a very young form of an insect that looks like a worm


