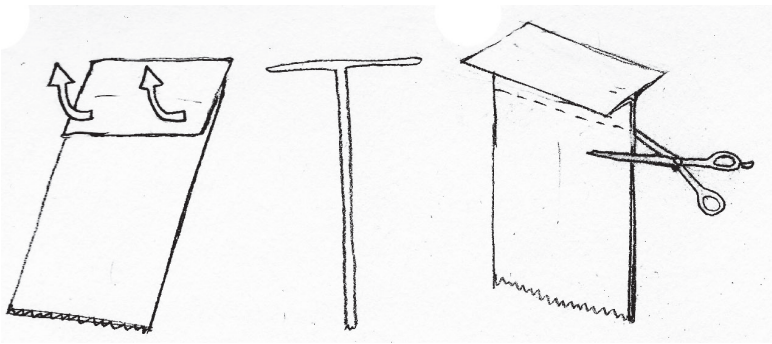
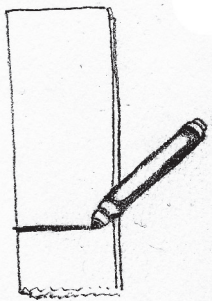


# Antler Crown Project

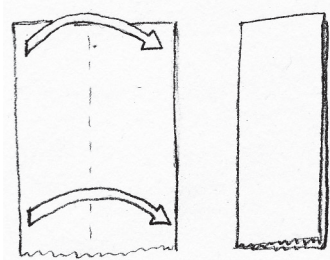
## Instructions:



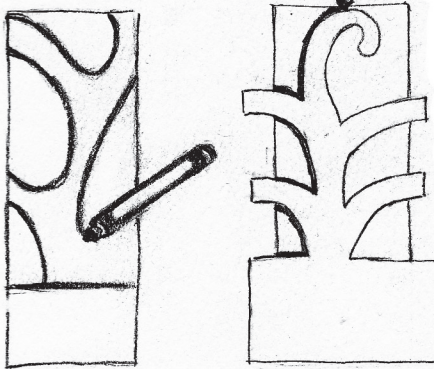
**1.** Hold up your flat bag and unfold the bottom so it looks like the capitol letter "T" from the side. Cut the top of the "t" off.



**2.** Fold the bag in half hot-dog style or lengthwise.

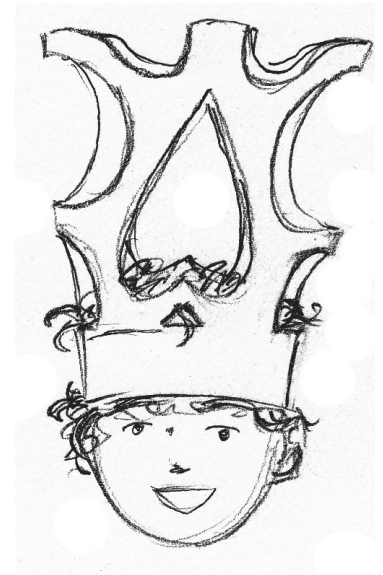
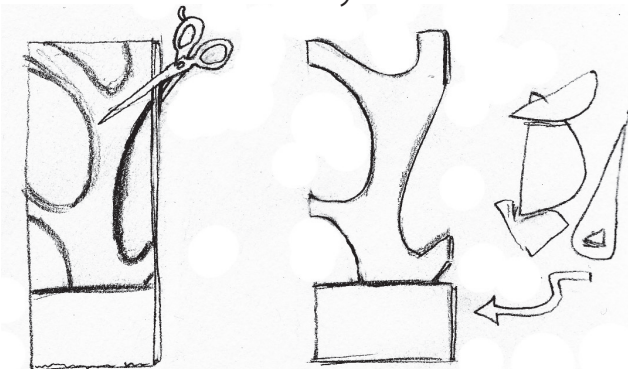


**3.** Draw a line across the bag (about 2 inches above either open end). This is the base line.



**4.** Draw (or trace) your antler design up from the base line you have just drawn. Have some of your lines go off either edge of the bag --this will help support your antlers!

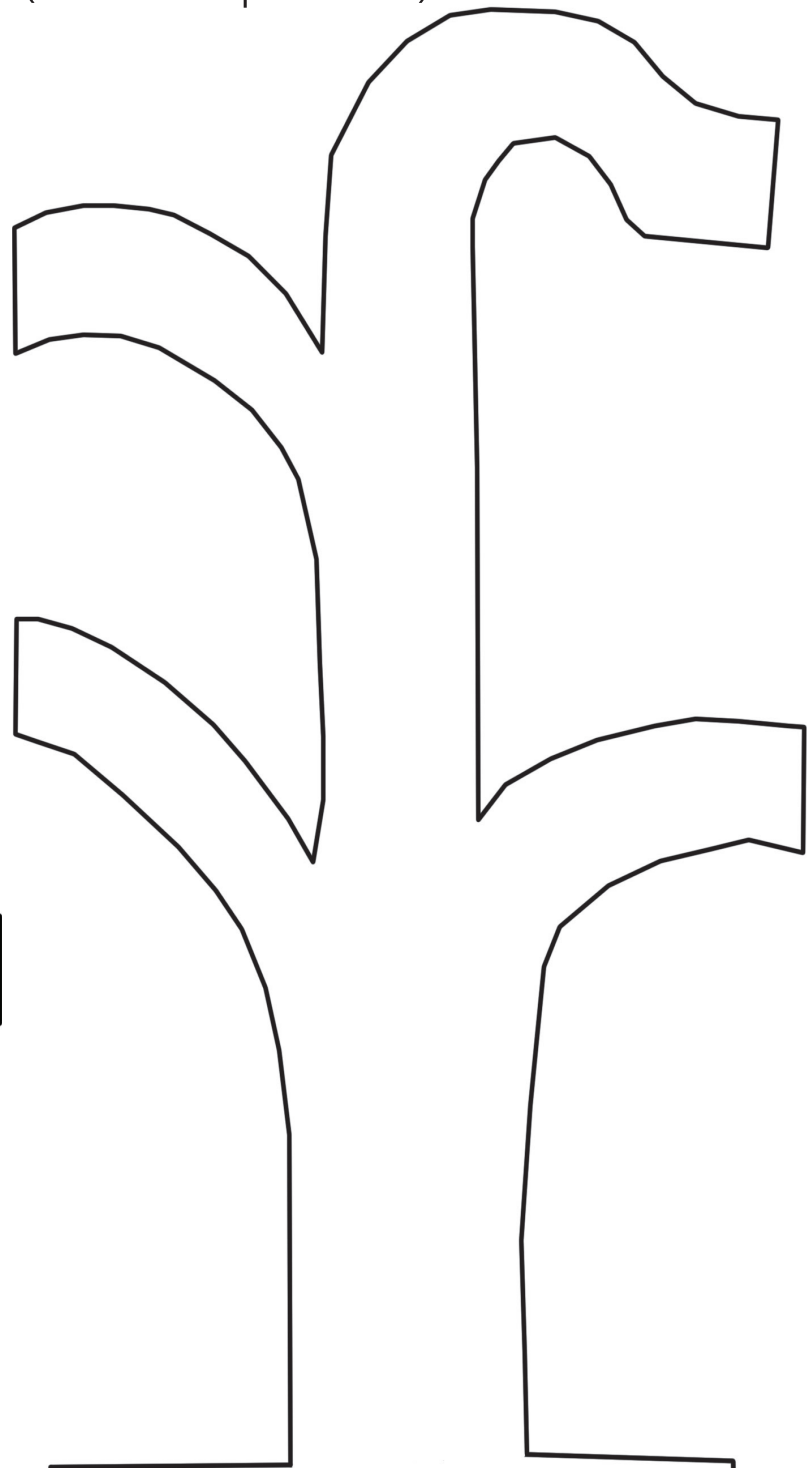
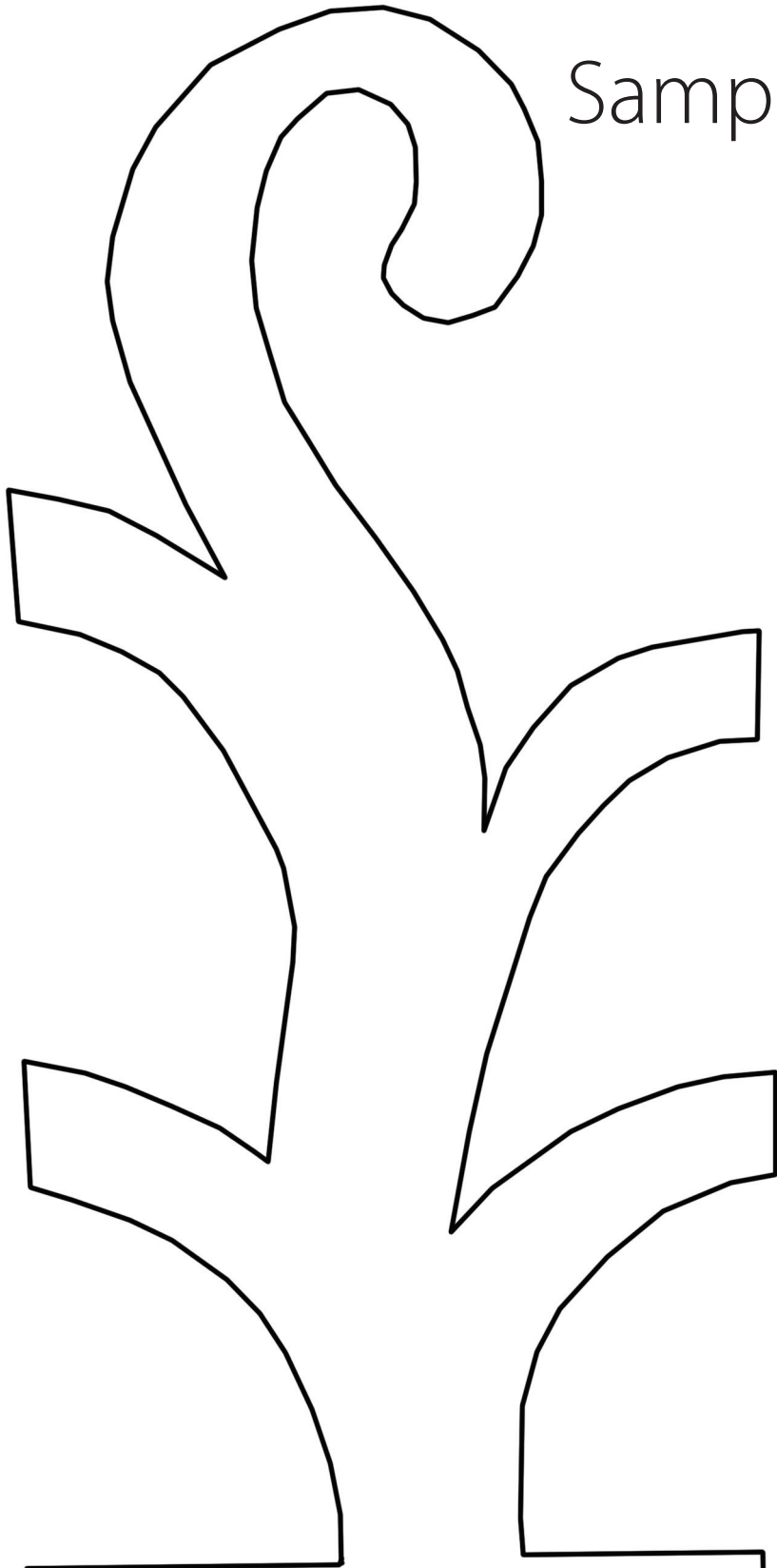
**5.** Cut out around the antler you have drawn, but do not cut all the way across the base line. It will help make your crown wearable if those bottom 2 inches are still attached to your antlers!



**6.** Unfold your bag and try it on!

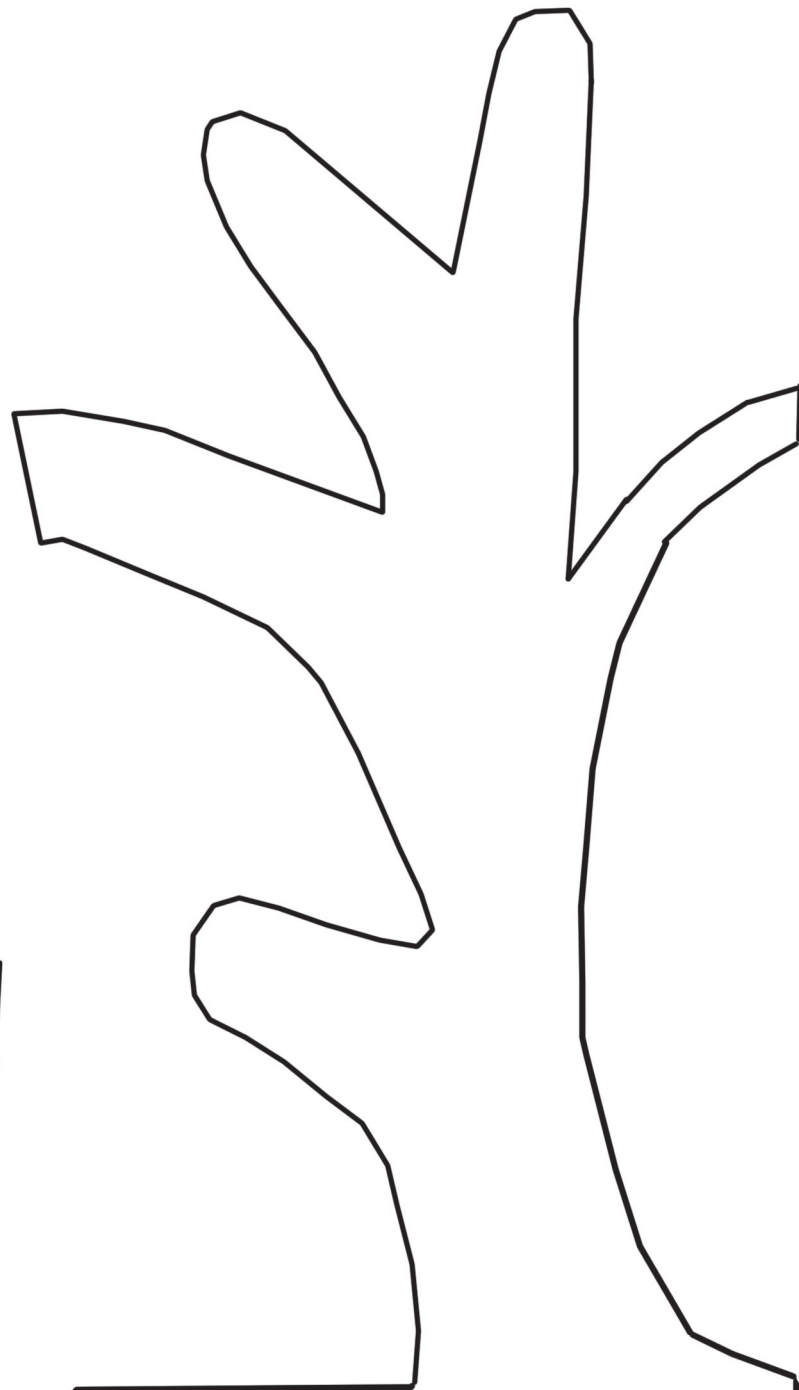
