MINUTES

I. Call to order.

The Intragovernmental Conference Committee Meeting of August 5, 2024, was called to order by Chair Stelzner at 11:08 a.m.

II. Review and approval of agenda for Monday, August 5, 2024.

III. Review and approval of minutes for Monday, June 24, 2024.

Chair Stelzner asked for a motion to approve the minutes from June 24, 2024. Committee member Vanzi moved to approve the minutes. Committee Member White seconded. Motion approved 3-0

IV. Review and discussion of the proposed Intragovernmental Conference Committee Rules

The Committee discussed the enactment of its set of rules. Committee member White raised a question on how to address the use of Mayor and Council, and it was agreed upon to use the terms Petitioner and Respondent. Committee member White asked for the addition of an entrance of appearance. Committee member Vanzi requested the addition of witness and exhibit lists.
