2 responsible company official shall certify that the business does not expect to
3 employ more than seven (7) employees in the first year of operations. For
4 existing businesses seeking certification as a Microbusiness, the responsible
5 company official shall submit the business's Form ES-903A, Quarterly Wage
6 and Contribution Report, submitted to the New Mexico Department of
7 Workforce Solutions, or Form TRD-31109, Quarterly Wage, Income
8 Withholding and Workers' Compensation Fee Report submitted to the New
9 Mexico Taxation and Revenue Department as proof of meeting the definition of
10 Microbusiness.)

11 SECTION 2. § 9-6-15 of the Albuquerque Food Service and Retail Ordinance
12 is hereby amended as follows:

13 § 9-6-15 ADMINISTRATION AND INTERPRETATION. The Enforcement
14 Authority shall be responsible for the administration and enforcement of this
15 Ordinance. In the event of a conflict between the provisions of the
16 Albuquerque Food Service and Retail Ordinance and any administrative rules
17 promulgated by the City Administration and/or Environmental Health
18 Department, the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.

19 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause,
20 word or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or
21 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not
22 affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Council
23 hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section,
24 paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any
25 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

26 SECTION 4. COMPILATION. SECTIONS 1 and 2 of this Ordinance amend,
27 are incorporated in, and are to be compiled as part of the Revised Ordinances
28 of Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994.

29 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance takes effect five days after
30 publication by title and general summary.




