- Various companies unfortunately don't communicate with each other.
  - o ATL-BOLO availability time frame to officers.
- Officer involves shooting brief overview
  - o Secure the scene and render aid to whoever might be hurt
  - o When an officer-involved shooting occurs, a lethal weapon has been employed and deployed.
  - o The multiagency task force arrives, which consists of other police agencies that conduct impartial investigations.
  - o Crime scene evidence collected and processed.
  - o Criminal element possible charges are drafted.
  - o Officers are put on administrative leave.
  - o The officers get interviewed and, after they go through a behavioral health screening and return to work process. This process is different for each officer.
- There are media briefings.
- Criminal process – The case is brought before the court or DA's office and they review everything to see if there will be charges for the citizen and officer involved.
