 - Call takers answering emergency and non-emergency calls.
 - They determine location, priority type, and when they gather the information, it gets inputted into the computer-aided dispatch system. Then the dispatchers radio contact the officers about the information provided from the caller.
 - National crime information center operations—They are responsible for communicating nationally with other agencies regarding warrants and stolen vehicles for confirmation if they are still outstanding.
 - Telephone reporting unit – handle over the phone and online reporting.
 - Always one supervisor on duty for any issue of concern.

- Rapid west next gen 911 – a system integrated with their system. This technology gives GPS location of the cell device. There is also the ability to text 911.
