- 5. Erika L. Wilson, Emergency Communications Center Manager, Albuquerque Police Department**
 - They answer the 911 calls first then they answer the 242-cops (2677) line.
 - There are twenty-two people in training out of forty-two.
 - Currently there are forty vacancies.
 - These numbers are not exact but they answer about 3000 plus calls.
 - The training depends on the job position.
 - A 911 dispatcher does four to six weeks of cross-training. Then they go through a three to four-month one-on-one with a trainer in taking calls. Afterward they go to the state academy for three weeks to get state certified which is required for New Mexico.
 - A dispatcher will be with a trainer for five to twelve weeks.
 - 911 calls will ask questions to get as much information from the caller.

- They have a one to five-priority call system.
 - As of March 2024 ACS, dispatch transferred to APD dispatch.
