 - **Crime** – There are a few categories that are down in crime. At the beginning of the year residential burglary and auto theft were high, year to date both categories are getting even. There were several juvenile offenders they couldn't book in January and February. Homicide was a rough couple of days. They moved resources back to the central area. They are still down 9-10 homicides for the year. Shooting with injuries decreased and robberies are down about 50%.
 - **Recruiting** – There are 920 sworn officers with an additional 35 in training, for a total of 955. There is an upcoming class with about 20 cadets. The PSAs are understaffed. At one point, they had over 100 PSAs; currently, there are 65 PSAs. The drop in PSAs is due to some becoming police officers, and others going to transit safety.
 - **Settlement** - By the beginning of next year they should have less than 40 to 50 paragraphs monitored by the DOJ. The rest have been dismissed or in self-monitoring. Currently, about 56% of the consent decree has been dismissed.
 - **Community outreach** – Continue to work with the ambassador program. They are in the process of working with churches and religious organizations.
 - The DWI investigation is still pending, and the traffic accident is pending litigation, and he got a letter of reprimand.

 - They are now getting dispatched from the APD 911 call center.
 - They were created in 2021,
 - They are now 24-7 as of September 2023.
