8. Erika Wilson Emergencies Communications Center Manager APD

- The emergency communication center is located in the southwest part of Albuquerque on 114th st. and Central.
- They answer all 911 and 242-cops (2677)
- There are forty-two vacancies out of 142 positions. This is a nationwide issue.
- Answer for police, and they do screen calls for other emergencies for medical and fire.
- When a person calls the dispatcher they get asked a series of questions.
- New Mexico is going into a next-generation technology within a year.
- They handle about 1,000,000 calls annually
- They take calls for ACS. They have been answering calls for ACS since March 2022.
- The Atlas One app is where a person can enter the incident and it gets entered into dispatch or if needed it gets routed to other resources.
- Process to get hired
 - Fill out the application, they review the application every two weeks
 - An individual goes through a typing test and a multitasking test
 - When hired they do a sit-a-long
 - They undergo an extensive background check similar to when hired as a police officer.
 - Including a drug test.
 - They are in a classroom for six weeks.
 - The individual will do three to four months of learning how to answer 911 and 242-cops calls.
 - It takes about six months to train a 911 dispatcher and up to one year to train a dispatcher
 - They then do a three weeks state certification course, and get state certificated. Which is required in New Mexico.

9. NE Area Commander Ryan Nelson crime update

- Offenders are getting younger
- He recently had to arrest an 11-year-old and a 6-year-old.
- Juvenile crimes are generally committed with stolen guns
- Social media exacerbates problems.
- Twenty-six percent of offenders in the County juvenile system have committed murders.
- Shoplifting is down slightly this month
- Auto burglaries are up slightly
- Larceny 180 this month
- Commercial robberies 36
- 7,452 calls for service, down slightly
- Many guns have been stolen from glove boxes/ elsewhere inside cars
