4. **Chief of Police Harold Medina APD Update**
  - The four main topics he discussed were crime, compliance, recruiting and community engagement.
  - Crime- The biggest issue in the community.
    - Traffic accidents are down double digits by 20%
    - Traffic citations increased by 80% for the department. The misdemeanor citations issued to individuals for criminal trespassing were the highest. Since balloon fiesta there-have been nearly five hundred citations issued.
    - Violent crime could possibly be down, however It is inconclusive that this time.
  - Compliance – The department should be around 88% Consent Decree compliance if everything goes well from the last visit.
    - Third report in a row with an increase in compliance.
  - Recruiting –APD has opened up a lot of jobs that once required uniformed officers to civilian employment, and it has worked well.
    - Permanently assigning three PSA's (Public Service Aids) to the Bosque and two in the foothills.
    - There are approximately forty-five on the job training, and the academy class there are around thirty-three cadets.
      - Continue to hire PSA's
  - Community Policing - Hired a full-time Public Outreach Coordinator Danielle Silva. There are projects in the works for different theme months. (Ex. domestic violence, autism, and etc.)

## **5. NW Area Commander David Saladin crime update**

- Down on every violent crime category compared to last year.
- Slightly up in auto thefts. The cars are being stolen in many locations but mostly from apartment complexes.
- Use of Force for December
  - 4,700 citizen contact
  - Three Uses of Force in the NW Area Command in December
- Pete Gelabert NW Crime Prevention Specialist
  - Coffee with a cop on January 24, 2023 at 9AM – 11AM located at Donut mart 3301 Coors NW
  - Starting up with the business coalition, and their first business is going to be with the west block business, and surrounding businesses, off I-40 and Coors and further north. Their presentations are coming from the Albuquerque community safety team, and they'll be presenting on how they deal with homelessness with a mental illness and providing resources.
  - West bluff business coalition on Monday February 6, 2023 from 10:00 AM to 11:30 AM at electric play house in their meeting room.
