- 1. Call to Order:** 6:02 PM

- 4. NW Area Commander Chris Patterson**
 - Ventana Ranch – Vehicles were vandalized by young people, and BCSO took over because it was in their jurisdiction.
 - Auto theft – In the Ventana ranch area, APD took action with bait vehicles and extra cameras in that area.
 - Crime stats for the last thirty days – There were about 26,000 calls for service
 - Auto theft – 52
 - Robberies – 4
 - There was an increase in shoplifting as the holidays approached.
 - The graveyard and swing shift created a tact plan for the shoplifting and auto burglaries. They will be focusing on Ellison to West Bluff on Coors. They started the tact plan last Saturday.
 - Holiday tact plan for shopping centers by riverside plaza to begin on black Friday.
 - Traffic tact plan to identify problem area. Last week they concentrated on areas 528 to golf course issuing about 100 citations within the three days.
- 5. Crime Prevention Specialist Pete Gelabert**

- Coffee with a cop on November 21, 2023, at the Wecks on 6311 Riverside Plaza NW from 8 AM – 10 AM
- He attended a West Bluff meeting and the mayor attended this meeting. He spoke about being proactive and what the city will be doing in the Northwest.
- West side coalition meeting on the first Wednesday of each month.
- He also attended the 7 bar HOA annual meeting.

6. NW Area Commander Chris Patterson

- Traffic issues
 - Speed cameras – There are two new cameras on Coors southbound and northbound.
- There is a pilot study to use noise cameras, currently, the city council is looking into the new device.
- Traffic operations – There is a tact plan in the NW to work on problem areas such as Unser, Montanyo, and Golf course
- Traffic crashes utilize PSAs and field officers depending on the severity of the crash. On Saturday the NW area command doubled in PSA's.
