- 4. APD Chief Harold Medina
 - Settlement agreement Currently if everything goes the way it is going, on January 31st, there could be about five to seven paragraphs that could be dropped. These paragraphs are actively being monitored.
 - Crime Two major crime categories are in the plus: residential and commercial burglaries city-wide, auto theft is down, shoplifting is down, and auto burglary is down. Homicides and assaults are down from last August. By the end of the year, they should finish in homicides with a negative. Felony warrants are getting cleared.
 - Recruiting There is a possibility of 100 officers by next year.
 - Officer engagement Partnership with tribal communities around the state is going well. They assisted with a feast day in Jemez and Taos. The department continues to have monthly meetings with the tribal communities in the metro and statewide to share information.
 - Recent There have been three officers involved shooting within the last five months and did a media briefing.
 - Operations on central from San Pedro to Wyoming getting resources in that area and arresting individuals with felony warrants.
