  - In 2014 DOJ findings letter that created the formation the court approved settlement agreement. This document said that APD had a pattern of practice

unreasonable that lead to deadly use of force. A systemic contributor to the pattern of use of force included supervisors, recruiting, hiring, policy and training.

- There are different levels of the CASA
  - The paragraphs are 270 -280 that they have to achieve to be in compliance
    - a. Three levels of compliance
      - i. Primary – police in place
      - ii. Secondary – Needs to have training develop and implemented
      - iii. Operation – demonstrates and show in real time on how there are operating in the public, street and community.
  - In the CASA there is a thirty-eight percent suspended compliance.
    - These paragraphs suspended are no longer monitored.
  - Next months initiatives to go to the schools and talk to the youth about policing and future careers.
  - There is a pilot project in place called the university area command, the area command will be active on March 10, 2023
    - There is one acting deputy area commander, six sergeants, six lieutenants, and five officers from different area commands.
