 - Weapon violation down 35%

6. Transit Safety Officer Zachery Cortez w/ PSA, APD officer and Commander

- Traffic systems by bus stops
- APD took over last year and the 1st class will be completed in December. They went live in January in the field. They were only in the SW corridor between Wyoming and San Mateo on the central corridor.
- Provide resources and immediate response to the bus stops and on buses.
- In a short time, they just patrolled the streets to manning the Alvarado transit center.
- They assist in the area command tact plans.
- They monitor the art bus cameras.
- The purpose of the PSAs is to relay information. When information gets relayed back, they decide whether sworn personnel is needed or contact the individual to get them moving along in resolving the situation or conflict.

- Deter anyone that's not up to no good.
- They are talking to people on the buses, making strides to combat that for transit safety.
