 - Change to expand their opportunities to make the petition for a red flag order. To take a gun away from someone who has suicidal and homicidal ideologies.
 - Change in auto theft penalties when convicted of auto theft and then convicted of another auto theft differently they can put everything together as a felony and prosecute them.
- The 60-day session is about a 3^{rd} away through, and bills are being introduced.

- He goes over a few SOP's and if anyone has any recommendations let him know.

- Extreme risk firearm protection order (ERF Pro) -
 - When an individual is having a mental health crisis or domestic violence incident an officer arrives on scene and uses the red flag law to remove firearms from the home. Contrary to their 2nd amendment to having firearms.
