- **4.** New business Neighbors hear gunshots in the park, requesting shotspotter and more patrol. The community discussed adding more patrols from the Bernalillo Sheriff's Department. The Valley area commander said they are working to get cameras at the park.

5. Valley Area Commander Jose Sanchez's crime update

- The problem area is the San Jose neighborhood, where they hear gunshots. The neighborhood is requesting more patrol and resources to the area.
- Traffic enforcement the bus stop on Indian School near Valley apartments.
- Tact plan on the Rio Grande and Montano they had about 80 citations.

6. Britney Martinez Crime Prevention Specialist

• They are going door to door teaching residents how to report gunshots and engaging with the community.

7. Violence intervention DA Sam Bregman, ACS, and APD Commander

- ACS spoke about the programs they offer to provide services to the community
 - o Hospital base intervention program
 - Violence intervention program
 - Opioid prevention and education program
 - School base violence intervention program
- DA Sam Bregman
 - o He has a total of 20,000 referred cases

- o The staffing is at 330 employees, and he has hired over 120 prosecutors
- o Crime overall is starting to get better, homicides are down and people are convicted either through trial or plea agreement.
- o His office has diverted 1,872 cases this year into specialty courts.
- o Juvenile crime
 - His office had charged 24 juveniles with murder.
 - How are juveniles getting guns?
 - There are not enough resources to keep juveniles out of trouble.
