FLOOR AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO R-25-114

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY COUNCILOR: Grout

On page 1, beginning on line 16, amend Section 1 as follows:

[GENERAL FUND—110

Health, Housing and Homelessness Department

Affordable Housing 250,000

These funds shall be reserved for the development and implementation of a public-facing dashboard, specifically focusing on the behavior health opioid settlement and housing assistance related to affordable housing. The purpose of this dashboard is to enhance transparency and public engagement by providing real-time data and insights into the City's affordable housing initiatives.

Explanation: EC-25-292 removed the reserve of \$250,000 for the Public Facing Dashboard for the HHH department within Fund 265 in the Affordable Housing program. This amendment restores the full Affordable Housing funds from the original bill (R-24-106) in Fund 265 for the Prepaid Rapid Rehousing program. It also reallocates funding from DTI to HHH in order to provide funding to the department for the public facing dashboard focusing on Affordable Housing initiatives.

AMENDMENT SPONSORED BY COUNCILOR: Grout

On page 1, after line 24, begin a new section as follows:

[Section 3. That the amount of \$600,000 is hereby reserved in fund 305, Metropolitan Redevelopment Area, Activity 7870030 for the East Central Gateway Sign and lighting.]

Explanation: This amendment creates a reserve within Fund 305 MISC MRA 2019 for a total of \$600,000 to be used for the East Central Gateway sign and lighting projects.
