- IV. HOSPITAL SYSTEMS REPORTS
 - a. Lovelace: Nothing to report
 - b. **VAMC:** Looking for Cardiologist and they are hiring interventional cardiologists. Getting better data and it appears that diverts for head injuries are decreasing.
 - **c. Presbyterian:** Nothing to report, LCMC isn't taking patients at this time.
 - d. University of New Mexico: Go live date for peds center is the 29 of June.
- V. PAC report: Chief Ortiz
 - a. Pediatric transport guideline has discrepancies from state vs. local
 - 1. Trying to get a guideline that aligns with the stated and will make recommendations to this committee
 - b. Suboxone special skill
 - c. DOT inspection on the 25
 - d. AAS tariff approval and how it affects other agencies
 - e. Fentanyl dosing and changes to come to decrease mis-dosing

VI. OLD BUSINESS

- a. Pedi-stat integration progress update-Integration is being worked on at the developer.
- b. Black divert language- Need to finalize edits and vote on
 - Motion to approve with edits by Dr. Medoro and second by Dr. Habratt
 - 2. Passes unanimously
- c. Suboxone special skill submission- Has been approved, next step is a meeting to confirm consent forms and what transports will look like. Hoping for roll out in the fall.

VII. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Stroke guideline language regarding EKG acquisition (Dr. Medoro)- background AAS has QI team and this year's focus is on Stroke. We are not meeting numbers and haven't had significant change. Working on QI PSA's. Doing follow ups on the outlying numbers. Found delays on scene are due to ECG prior to leaving the scene. Culture is that crews feel the 12 lead is needed prior to transport initiation.
 - 1. Asking for a change in the guideline to change to prioritization of transport of stroke pt over 12 lead needs.
 - 1. Will make a draft and bring it back to this committee to be voted on.
- b. MDC Seizure Protocol (Dr Barrett)- Ordering procedures for jails cause trouble in ordering Versed. Only option is Diazepam
 - 1. Asking to change the guideline to have diazepam be equal to the Versed IM dosage.
 - 1. Motion made by Dr. Medoro to change guideline language
 - 2. Passes unanimously

VIII. Research

- a. Cerebral oximetry/pupillometry actively collecting data
- b. CAVALIER trauma study awaiting legal agreements
- c. Hemashock device working on IRB submission

IX. Agency Updates

- a. UNM Rapid response- nothing major for rapid response; Medbow, metro detention center- Officers bring people to intake and they are working on the process to get officers out quicker; Sandia labs
- b. AAS- Tariff increase should be good for AAS and hopefully for the rest of the state. BCFR and AAS are responding out to Sandia Pueblo; Superior-
- c. Kirtland Fire, Corrales Fire- Nothing to report; BCFD-Nothing to report, AFR-Good Sam has been purchased and we are trying to train the dispatchers. Looking to go live by the end of the year.
