ANY PROVISION OF THE FIREWORKS LICENSING AND SAFETY ACT OR THIS CODE IS GUILTY OF A <u>MISDEMEANOR</u> AND UPON CONVICTION SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) AND/OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN NINETY DAYS.
