



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND NOTICE OF 15-DAY COMMENT PERIOD  
FOR THE  
2023 CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE EVALUATION REPORT (CAPER)**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Albuquerque, Department of Health, Housing & Homelessness will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, September 4, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. at the Los Griegos Health & Social Services Center located at 1231 Candelaria NW, 87107. The hearing site is accessible to persons with disabilities. Auxiliary Aids and language interpreters can be made available during the hearing upon prior request. The purpose of the hearing is to present the Department's 2023 Consolidated Annual Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER) and to provide an opportunity for City residents to provide feedback. This report explains how the Department allocated and expended its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG & CDBG-CV CARES), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Entitlement funds. The CAPER addresses progress achieved in attaining goals and meeting priorities.

A 15-day public comment period will begin on Thursday, September 5, 2024, and end on Friday, September 20, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. All residents, property owners, persons with disabilities, immigrants, seniors, low-income, children and youth, homeless persons, and other stakeholders of the City of Albuquerque are encouraged to submit written comments or questions regarding the draft CAPER to Monica Montoya, Department of Health, Housing & Homelessness, Old City Hall, 400 Marquette NW, 5th Floor, Room 504, 87102 or e-mail at [mtmontoya@cabq.gov](mailto:mtmontoya@cabq.gov).
