1 2 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING **BETWEEN AFSCME LOCAL 624 TRANSIT** 3 AND THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE 4 REGARDING MOTORCOACH OPERATORS AND SUN VAN CHAUFFEURS 5 **SPLIT SHIFT DIFFERENTIAL PAY** 6 7 THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is entered into by and between 8 9 the City of Albuquerque ("City") and the AFSCME Local 624 Transit ("Union"), (collectively, the "Parties") and serves as an addendum to the Agreement Between the City 10 of Albuquerque and AFSCME Local 624 Transit Union ("CBA") effective July 1, 2023, 11 12 which terminates on June 30, 2026. 13 WHEREAS, Section 40.2.2 of the CBA allows the Parties to enter into written 14 Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) during the term of the CBA, and 15 16 WHEREAS, City of Albuquerque Transit Department staffing remains a serious 17 problem for the City, the Union, and the citizens of Albuquerque, and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, the Parties agree that a Split Shift Differential will help incentivize Motorcoach Operators and Sun Van Chauffeurs and provide needed services to our 21 customers during peak hours, and 22 23 24 25 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED 26 27 28 I. **Term of MOU.** This MOU is effective the date the last party signs the agreement and shall remain in full force until the current CBA expires or until 29 a successor Agreement is reached, whichever occurs last. 30 31 II. 32 Section 12.1.2 of the 624 Transit CBA shall be amended to read 12.1.2 Drivers assigned to split runs will receive split run differential pay for their 33 actual time worked based on the following formula: twenty-five cents (\$.25) per 34 hour for runs with a total time less than 13 hours; thirty cents (\$.30) per hour for 35 runs with a total time more than 13 hours; or thirty five cents (\$.35) per hour for 36 runs with a total time more than 13.5 hours. 37 III. Section 12.1.3.3 of the 624 Transit CBA shall be amended to read "Differential 38 Pay will be provided to all those assigned split runs at a rate of \$10.00 per hour 39 for time between the splits. 40 41 42 IV. No Further Agreement. This MOU incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understanding between the parties hereto concerning the pilot program to be 43 enacted hereunder, and all such agreements, covenants, and understandings have 44 been merged into this MOU. This MOU expresses the entire MOU and 45

1		understanding between the parties with respect to said services. No prior
2		agreement or understanding, verbal or otherwise, of the parties or their agents
3		shall be valid or enforceable unless embodied in this MOU.
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5	I.	Severability. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this MOU
6		or any application thereof shall be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect,
7		the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained
8		herein and any other application thereof shall not in any way be affected or
9		impaired thereby.
