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A RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING UNIFORM STANDARDS FOR RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED BY THE
ALBUQUERQUE HUMAN RIGHTS BOARD.

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WHEREAS, §11-3-5 (A) of the Albuquerque Human Rights Ordinance allows the Board to set such rules and regulations as are necessary for the operation of the Board.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ALBUQUERQUE HUMAN RIGHTS BOARD:

SECTION 1. SEVERABILITY STANDARD

The Severability Standard for Board Resolutions is hereby adopted.

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word, or phrase of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such a decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this resolution. The Board hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word, or phrase of this resolution irrespective of any provision being declared invalid or unenforceable.

SECTION 2. ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION STANDARD.

The Administrative Instruction Standard for Board Resolutions is hereby adopted.

This resolution is to be signed and published on the webpage for the Board under the section titled "Recent Documents" within 10 calendar days of the resolution being adopted by the Board and later moved into the online archive by request of the chairperson of the board or by a quorum of the members of the Board.

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A RESOLUTION

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RECOMMENDING ENHANCED REPORTING PRACTICES RELATING TO CERTAIN
ACTIVITIES OF THE METRO SECURITY DIVISION OF THE GENERAL SERVICES
DEPARTMENT

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WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Human Rights Board (Board) is tasked by the Human Rights Ordinance (HRO) to preserve and protect human dignity; and to use its best efforts to promote respect between Albuquerque’s governmental agencies and the citizens they are meant to serve; and to review all existing and proposed ordinances and policies which relate to Human Rights; AND

WHEREAS, the HRO requires the Board to use its best efforts to promote mutual trust, understanding and respect among the citizens of the Albuquerque community and between the citizens and their governmental agencies and endeavor that all citizens may enjoy their rights and pursue their opportunities on an equal basis without discrimination as to race, color, religion, sex, national origin or ancestry, age, physical or mental disability, pregnancy, childbirth or condition related to childbirth or pregnancy, sexual orientation, gender, or gender identity.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ALBUQUERQUE HUMAN RIGHTS BOARD:

SECTION 1. The Board hereby recommends enhanced public reporting practices and policies relating to the Metro Security Division of General Services Department including, but not limited to:

- (A) Use of Force
- (B) General Policies and Procedures
- (C) 911 Calls Diverted

Section 2. The Board Hereby requests the publication of the following documents relating to the Metro Security Division of the General Services Department:

- (A) Related Ordinances, Resolution, Policy or other such documents
- (B) Organizational Chart
- (C) Training Policies
