4	NOTICE REQUIREMENTS FOR MEETINGS OF THE BOARD
5	WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque ("City") Human Rights Board
6	("Board") met in regular session at the Office of Equity and Inclusion,
7	November 20, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. as required by law; and
8	WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(B) (NMSA 1978) of the Open Meetings
9	Act states that "[A]ll meetings of a quorum of members of any board,
10	commission, administrative adjudicatory body or other policymaking body of
11	any state agency, any agency or authority of any county, municipality, district
12	or any political subdivision, held for the purpose of formulating public policy,
13	including the development of personnel policy, rules, regulations or
14	ordinances, discussing public business or for the purpose of taking any action
15	within the authority of or the delegated authority of any board, commission or
16	other policymaking body are declared to be public meetings open to the public
17	at all times except as may be otherwise provided in the Constitution of New
18	Mexico, or the provisions of the Open Meetings Act;" and
19	WHEREAS, any meetings subject to the Open Meetings Act at which
20	the discussion or adoption of any proposed resolution, rule, regulation or
21	formal action occurs shall be held only after reasonable notice to the public;
22	and

23	WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(D) of the Open Meetings Act requires the Board to
24	determine annually what constitutes reasonable notice of its public meetings; and
25	WHEREAS, Section 2-6-1-4(B) (ROA 1994) of the City of Albuquerque Public
26	Boards, Commissions and Committees Ordinance requires that every public board,
27	commission or committee created by the City of Albuquerque must determine what is
28	reasonable notice to the public of its meetings; provided that in no event shall notice be
29	less than the notice required for Albuquerque City Council meetings;
30 31 32 33	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE HUMAN RIGHTS BOARD, the Governing Body of the City's Office of Equity and Inclusion, that:
34	Section 1. Unless otherwise specified, all meetings of the Board shall be held in
35	the Main Conference Room in the Office of Equity and Inclusion, the
36	Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Government Center Building at 1 Civic Plaza NW,
37	Albuquerque, NM 87102, starting at 4:00 p.m. Mountain Time Zone.
38	Section 2. Unless otherwise specified, regularly scheduled meetings of the Board
39	shall be held bi-monthly on the third (3 rd) Tuesday of the months of January, March,
40	May, July, September and November. Public notice in writing of any other regularly
41	scheduled meetings will be given at least five (5) days in advance of the meeting date.
42	The agenda for a regularly scheduled meeting will be available to the public at least 72
43	hours (3 days) prior to such meeting. Copies of the agenda will be available to the public
44	upon request from the Director of the Office of Equity and Inclusion, whose phone

number is 505-768-4595 and whose office is located in the Albuquerque/Bernalillo
County Government Center Building at 1 Civic Plaza NW, Albuquerque, NM 87102.

47 Section 3. Special meetings of the Board may be called by the Chairperson of the
48 Board or by a majority of the Board members upon three (3) days advance notice. The
49 agenda for a special meeting will be available to the public at least seventy two (72)
50 hours prior to such special meeting. Copies of the agenda will be available to the public
51 upon request from the Director of the Office of Equity and Inclusion, whose phone
52 number is 505-768-4595 and whose office is located in the Albuquerque/Bernalillo
53 County Government Center Building at 1 Civic Plaza NW, Albuquerque, NM 87102.

54 Section 4. Emergency meetings of the Board will be called only under unforeseen circumstances that demand immediate action by the Board to protect the health, safety 55 and property of citizens or to protect the public body from substantial financial loss. The 56 57 Board will avoid holding emergency meetings whenever possible. Emergency meetings 58 may be called by the Chairperson or a majority of the Board members upon twenty-four 59 (24) hour's notice, unless threat of personal injury or property damage requires less Public notice for an emergency meeting shall include an agenda for the 60 notice. 61 emergency meeting.

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Section 5. For all meetings described in this resolution, public notice requirements are met if:

A. a printed notice of the date, time and place of the meeting is posted for public
viewing in the following location: in the 1st floor lobby of the Albuquerque/Bernalillo
County Government Center (City-County Building) at 1 Civic Plaza NW, Albuquerque,
NM 87102 and

B. an electronic copy of the notice is posted on the Board web page. Currently,
the Board web page address is <u>http://www.cabq.gov/humanrights</u> and this website
address may change from time to time as needed by the City or the Board.

C. Notice shall also be sent electronically to those broadcast stations (radio and 71 72 television) licensed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and newspapers 73 of general circulation in the State of New Mexico that (i) have submitted a written request for notice of public meetings to the Director of the Office of Equity and 74 Inclusion, whose office is located in the Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Government 75 76 Center Building at 1 Civic Plaza NW, Albuquerque, NM 87102, and (ii) have provided an electronic mail (e-mail) address to which public notices are to be sent. Currently, the 77 Board finds that the Director has not received any written requests for ongoing notice of 78 all Board meetings from any FCC licensed broadcast stations or from newspapers of 79 80 general circulation, located in New Mexico or anywhere else.

81 Section 6. In addition to the information specified above, all public notices shall
82 include the following language:

"NOTICE TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES: If you are a person with a disability
and require a reasonable accommodation to observe or participate in this meeting, please
contact Ms. Paula Bettencourt, whose phone number is 505-764-4595 and whose email
address is: <u>oei@cabq.gov</u> as soon as possible. Public documents, including the agenda
and minutes, can be provided in various accessible formats. Please contact the office if a
summary or other type of accessible format is needed. The meeting will occur in a room
that is accessible to persons in wheelchairs, by use of an elevator."

Section 7. Notice of Cancellations of meetings of the Board, and notice of 90 91 different meeting times and/or dates and/or locations, may be announced at prior 92 meetings of the Board. Sudden cancellations of meetings may occur if a quorum of Board members cannot or unexpected fail to attend a previously scheduled meeting time. 93 94 Different meeting dates and times may be needed if a regularly scheduled meeting date (such as a Monday) is a federal, state or city holiday and City offices are closed that day. 95 And different meeting dates and/or times and/or locations may be needed for a regularly 96 scheduled meeting date if there is inclement weather, or if the meeting location is not 97 available for use, or for other reasons. 98

99 Section 8. Notice of committee meetings, if any committees are formed, shall be100 equal to that specified in Sections 2 and 3 of this resolution.

101 Section 9. The Board may close a Meeting of the Board to the public only if the 102 subject matter of such discussion or action is exempted from the open to the public meeting requirement under Section 10-15- 1(H) (NMSA 1978) of the Open Meetings
Act.

A. If any open meeting is closed during such open meeting, the closure shall be approved by a majority vote of a quorum of the Board taken during the open meeting. The specific provision of law authorizing the closed meeting and the subject(s) to be discussed shall be stated with reasonable specificity in the motion to close the meeting to public observation and the vote of each individual member on the motion to close the meeting shall be recorded in the minutes, in a roll call vote. Only those subjects specified in the motion to close the meeting may be discussed by the Board in the closed meeting.

B. If a closed meeting is conducted when the Board is not in an open meeting, the closed meeting shall not be held until a written public notice of the meeting of the Board, appropriate under the circumstances, stating the specific provision of law authorizing the closed meeting and the subjects to be discussed with reasonable specificity, is given to Board members and to the public.

117 C. Following completion of any closed meeting, the minutes of the open meeting 118 that was closed, or the minutes of the next open meeting of the Board if the closed 119 meeting was separately scheduled, shall state whether the matters discussed in the closed 120 meeting were limited only to those specified in the motion to close the meeting or the 121 public notice of a closed meeting. D. Except as provided in Section 10-15-1(H) (NMSA 1978) of the Open Meetings Act, any action taken as a result of discussions in a closed meeting shall be made by a public vote of the Board in an open meeting.

- 125 Section 10. All resolutions, rules or parts of resolutions or rules, inconsistent with 126 this resolution, are hereby repealed only to the extent of such inconsistency. Such 127 implied repeal shall not be construed to revive any resolution, rule or part of any 128 resolution or rule that was previously repealed.

137 Section 12. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase of this
 138 resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent
 139 jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this
