## 4-26 DESTRUCTION/CAPTURE OF ANIMALS

## 4-26-1 Policy

It is the policy of Field Services to assist the New Mexico Department of Game and Fish and the City of Albuquerque Animal Control officers in the capture and/or destruction of wild/dangerous animals.

## 4-26-2 Rules and Procedures

- A. Wild/Dangerous Animal
  - 1. In all cases where an officer or ECC is notified of a wild animal in or near a populated area, ECC will call the New Mexico Department of Game and Fish and the Albuquerque Animal Control Center.
  - 2. Officer response will be to observe and follow the animal, not apprehend or contain the animal.
  - 3. Once the New Mexico Department of Game and Fish arrive on the scene, they have overall responsibility for all subsequent activities
  - 4. APD officers will be responsible for crowd management and control.
  - 5. If deadly force is needed, it will be carried out by the New Mexico Department of Game and Fish, if possible. If a life endangering situation or threat to public safety exists and it is necessary to destroy an animal, APD officers may use deadly force.
    - a. If the circumstances can warrant a delay, when there is no present danger due to temporary control or if the animal is mortally injured, then authorization for the use of deadly force must be granted by a supervisor. Personnel should consult with the New Mexico Department of Game and Fish or Albuquerque Animal Control Officers, if time permits.
