
Albuquerque, NM - PD | August, 2024 Blockwise - Executive Summary Report



Perception of Safety - **43**% of respondents overall felt mostly or completely safe in their neighborhood. **70**% of respondents stated there was a place in their local area they did consider unsafe. The most frequent reason given for this perception (**68**%) was because they "Personally witnessed or been a victim of crime". **65**% of respondents reported not being victims of crime in the past 6 months.

The feed provides open text comments identifying general themes and specific issues and locations. Homelessness was identified as the primary concern with respondents citywide (**176 Respondents**).
