




Perception of Safety - **39%** of respondents overall felt mostly or completely safe in their neighborhood. **71%** of respondents stated there was a place in their local area they did consider unsafe. The most frequent reason given for this perception **(65%)** was because they "Personally witnessed or been a victim of crime". **69%** of respondents reported not being victims of crime in the past 6 months.


