




Perception of Safety - **47**% of respondents overall felt mostly or completely safe in their neighborhood. **72**% of respondents stated there was a place in their local area they did consider unsafe. The most frequent reason given for this perception (**59**%) was because they "Personally witnessed or been a victim of crime". **69**% of respondents reported not being victims of crime in the past 6 months, indicating expanded community perspective access via the Zencity survey.

The feed provides open text comments identifying general themes and specific issues and locations. Homelessness was identified as the primary concern with respondents citywide (140 Respondents). Theft, Burglary and Break Ins (114) was the next highest concern followed by Drugs (96). Main concerns varied depending on the district. Click here to visit your site and explore your data.
