
Albuquerque, NM - PD | September, 2024 Blockwise - Executive Summary Report




Perception of Safety - 44% of respondents overall felt mostly or completely safe in their neighborhood. **70%** of respondents stated there was a place in their local area they did consider unsafe. The most frequent reason given for this perception **(62%)** was because they "Personally witnessed or been a victim of crime". **71%** of respondents reported not being victims of crime in the past 6 months.

The feed provides open-text comments identifying general themes and specific issues and locations. Homelessness was identified as the primary concern with respondents citywide **(207 Respondents)**.
