**Stolen Vehicles**: 56

Multiple vehicles stolen this month using the vehicle keys and reported by victims as being stolen by friends and relatives.

Entries via garage doors, back doors, 1 doggie door, leaving doors unlocked.

**Auto Burglaries:** 105

Entries: Using keys that were stolen, unforced entries (leaving doors unlocked, windows rolled down), breaking windows.

## <u>Items left in vehicles in July that were stolen:</u>

- Glock 17 hand gun, body armor, taser, magazines, 40 caliber Smith & Wesson.
- Multiple sets of house keys and garage door openers; vehicle keys (leaving keys in the vehicle and walking away).
- Multiple vehicle manuals, registration and insurance cards, vehicle titles, a one year entry
  pass into Mexico issued by Mexican authorities, ID Badges for work/access, birth
  certificates, numerous IDs, Social Security cards, credit and debit cards.
- Numerous wallets, purses.
- iPads, laptops, computers, cell phones, headphones, CDs, power tools, hand tools, batteries, children's books and comic books, medications, vehicle batteries.
- Gym bags and contents, aviation gear, rock climbing gear, fishing poles and tackle box, \$1500 in tools for work (noticed 2 strangers looking in his work truck and didn't call APD and walked in house and left the work truck unlocked; discovered truck burglarized when he woke up the next day).
- Diamond engagement ring, jewelry and watches, headphones.
- Cosmetics, case of water, mattress, shop vac, car seats, blankets, sun shades.
- \$15,000 cash left in vehicle, \$100 cash.
