Officer Corbin Waquie


In May 2023, he joined the Downtown Unit and made several arrests, in July and August of 2024, he cleared 25 Felony warrants and 19 misdemeanor warrants. As well as 12 Felony new charge arrests and 9 misdemeanor charge arrests. His hard work has also increased the quality of life and with his positive engagement within our community he has developed plans to address crime and disorder.

He proactively patrols identified problem areas and maintains a police presence to reduce any concerns among Downtown residents and businesses. Officer Waquie has developed an excellent rapport with the unhoused population and individuals who regularly visit the Downtown area, thereby de-escalating situations and connecting them with available resources.

He has been an excellent addition to the downtown team.

Message from Chief Medina

Hello Albuquerque, and Happy New Year! I hope everyone had a wonderful holiday season enjoying some time off with family and friends.

We are looking forward to 2025 after finishing out the year strong. Our Traffic Division continues to do



great work in the field. For the New Year's Eve holiday we partnered with several other agencies to enforce DWI throughout the city.

During the operation, 156 vehicles were stopped and 369 traffic citations were issued. DWI officers assisted with two traffic crash investigations and arrested 4 drivers for DWI.

As for our Criminal Investigations Division, in 2024, APD detectives solved 79 homicide cases.

A total of 125 murder suspects were arrested, a 6% increase from 2023 and the most in the history of the department. APD's homicide solve rate was also above 90% for the third straight year.



As we just wrapped up our Holiday Enforcement Plan, we will be making a public announcement with the results and highlighting some key individuals who were arrested multiple times during the operations.

I'm proud of our officers who have been working hard to make our shopping districts safer and for addressing these quality of life issues.

Additionally, we have increased enforcement to a historic part of our city that had experienced more crime this year.

As we have seen improvements, we continue to address the concerns and will be holding an event next month at Old Town Hobbies and Games, hosting Cops vs. Kids Game Day.



The event geared toward kids ages 8 and up will be on February 1, from 1:00p.m.-4:00p.m. We hope to see you there!

Thank you to our community for your continued support, we look forward to another great year ahead.

Albuquerque Metro Crime Stoppers is a community program that relies on anonymous tips to solve crimes and to locate fugitives from justice. Without anonymity of callers, the program cannot be offsetive.

Crime Stoppers pays rewards only for anonymous tips. Tipsters who identify themselves are not eligible for a reward.

Crime Stoppers has sole discretion to decide the amount of any reward to be paid, from zero to \$1,000

Crime Stoppers will pay rewards only for tips given directly to it. Any tip given to another source, such as law enforcement, will not be eligible for a Crime Stoppers reward.

Crime Stoppers does not pay rewards to any person who has a legal duty to assist in the arrest of suspects and fugitives.

Albuquerque Metro Crime Stoppers is a central New Mexico nonprofit organization that makes our communities safer by partnering with law enforcement and the media to solicit and reward anonymous tips that prevent, stop and solve crime.
