**1 Armed Robbery/Commercial:** 2500-block of Juan Tabo Blvd NE

**Entries:** Breaking windows, 1 door lock pried out, leaving vehicles unlocked, and leaving garage doors open.

**Items left inside unattended vehicles that were stolen:** Two handguns, 9 MM Taurus and 9 MM Ruger. Cameras. Silver cross and tools. Wallet, credit cards, IDs and \$1,000 charged at Wal Mart and \$80 at Circle K. Two mountain bikes and a laptop.

**Quick take aways –** The open garage doors continue to be easy entry points for burglars as well as leaving items in vehicles that were left unlocked. There are now two more guns on the streets in burglars' hands thanks to leaving fire arms in a vehicle and walking away. Many of our recent residential burglary reports note entries made through sliding glass doors and windows – if you don't have a burglar alarm with glass breakage/window movement wired in, get an additional locking mechanism to prevent windows and sliding glass doors being lifted or slid out of the tracks. Try not to provide a 'ladder' through your window – remove items near your windows that provide unintentional steps up to the window (a/c units, planters, etc.).
