Entries: Unforced entry, breaking a windshield, breaking a window.

Items left in unattended vehicles that were stolen: Wallet, cell phone. Four speakers and a handicap placard. Vehicle registration and insurance documents, employer's gas card, IDs, vehicle manual, cell phone, charger, case, sunglasses and gift card.

Trend / keeping pace: So far in September, our residential burglaries are keeping pace with our auto burglaries. This does not happen very often, and usually the auto burglaries outpace the rate of reported residential burglaries. It's time to take stock on your home security methods and assess your entry points to your home and how to limit access via locks, alarms, anti-lift/anti-slide mechanisms on windows and sliding glass doors.
