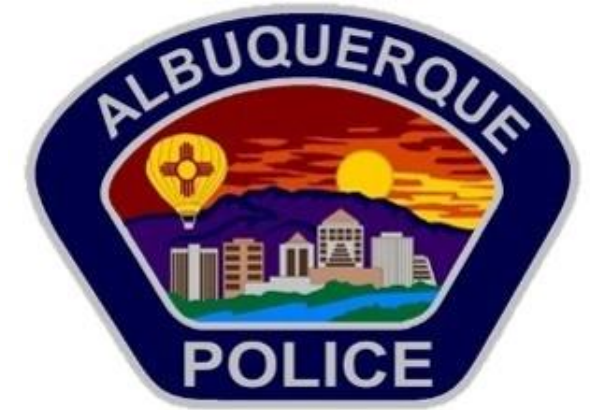

1. Auto Theft (APD) is an internal statistic for investigative purposes; Residential and Commercial burglaries are based on the Location Category which is identified by the officers (Residence/Home category is Residential, all other categories fall into Commercial)
 2. Sex Crimes is NIBRS codes 11A, 11B, 11C, 36A, 36B combined
 3. Homicides are from the Homicide Dashboard as of 3/03/2025; The date range is 01/01 – 3/04
 4. Arrests include all arrest types (taken into custody, on-site, cited, summoned), it will not include arrests without a classification
 5. Warrant Arrest stats are based on arrests where a warrant was involved, if a felony warrant charge was on the arrest, it counts as a Felony Warrant Arrest, if no Felony Warrant was involved, but there was a Misd, it is a Misd warrant arrest. This is a count of arrests, not warrants
 6. Criminal Trespass, Erecting a Structure in a Park, and Littering are based on arrests (citation, summons, taken into custody) and TraCS citations. Median City Code is based on the number of Field Contact Cards where “median” was used in the narrative as a warning of the Median City Code. CT Notice is based on the number of Field Contact Cards where “criminal trespass notice” or “CT notice” is used. Median Citation are citations (TraCS and Mark43) for all 8-2-7-2 ordinances
 7. CAD totals include Officer-Initiated and proactive calls
