


The Albuquerque Citywide Composting Initiative aims to implement an equity-focused, comprehensive household food waste diversion program.

An initial pilot project will utilize five community centers and the BioPark.





Equity

Frontline communities are those that experience the most immediate and worst impacts of climate change and are most often communities of color, Indigenous, and low-income.

Environmental injustices, such as the disproportionate siting of landfills and polluting industries in low-income and minority neighborhoods, perpetuate inequalities and exacerbate health disparities.

IN-HOME WITH BUCKET



- 1. Drop off bag of food waste at local green hub 1-2 times per week
- 2. Hauler picks up food waste from community center bins and brings it to commercial composter
- 3. Finished compost repurposed for local use


