1   **RESOLUTION**  
2     **ADOPTING A PROPOSITION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT THE**  
3     **NEXT MUNICIPAL ELECTION CONCERNING THE RENEWAL OF A QUARTER**  
4     **OF ONE PERCENT TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE GROSS RECEIPTS**  
5     **TAX.**

6         **WHEREAS, since FY/2000, the City has renewed a voter approved**  
7     **Transportation Infrastructure Gross Receipts Tax; and**

8         **WHEREAS, the voter approved Transportation Infrastructure Tax has**  
9     **provided hundreds of millions of dollars in funding for road rehabilitation,**  
10    **road maintenance, road deficiencies and transit operations; and**

11         **WHEREAS, Albuquerque residents, visitors, and businesses have**  
12    **benefited greatly by the improvements funded from the proceeds of the**  
13    **Transportation Infrastructure Tax; and**

14         **WHEREAS, the proceeds of the Transportation Infrastructure Tax have also**  
15    **provided approximately 20% of the City’s Transit operating funds; and**

16         **WHEREAS, the existing Transportation Infrastructure Tax contains a**  
17    **sunset provision which causes the tax to expire on June 30, 2020; and**

18         **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the residents of the City of**  
19    **Albuquerque to place a question on the ballot of the November 5, 2019**  
20    **Municipal Election regarding whether to continue to provide this source of**  
21    **road and transit funding.**

22     **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF**  
23     **ALBUQUERQUE:**

24         **Section 1. That the City Clerk is instructed to place the following proposal**  
25     **on the next municipal election ballot, and the qualified voters of the City of**

1 Albuquerque shall be permitted to vote “for” or “against” the following  
2 proposal:

3 PROPOSITION

4 SHALL THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE RENEW A ONE-QUARTER OF ONE  
5 PERCENT TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE GROSS RECEIPTS TAX  
6 WHICH SHALL BE DEDICATED SPECIFICALLY AND ONLY FOR THE  
7 FOLLOWING USES: NOT LESS THAN 57% FOR ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE  
8 IMPROVEMENTS, TO INCLUDE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT  
9 IMPROVEMENTS; 5% FOR TRAILS AND BIKEWAYS; AND 38% FOR TRANSIT?  
10 THIS IS A RENEWAL OF AN EXISTING TAX. THIS WILL NOT INCREASE THE  
11 TAX RATE.
